## How can West Virginia Wraparound help your cases?

West Virginia (WV) Wraparound helps connect youth who need mental health support with services and resources in their own homes and communities.

- ✓ No court order is required.
- ✓ No removal from the home is necessary.
- ✓ The child can be in the guardian's custody.
- ✓ Please refer cases to contact the Children's Crisis and Referral Line (CCRL) – open 24 hours/day, 7 days/week:
  - 844-HELP4WV (844-435-7498)
  - [HELP4WV.com](https://www.help4wv.com)
- ✓ In about four business days, the child will receive a connection to a program coordinator.
- ✓ If you must place a court order, order "WV Wraparound" and DoHS takes it from there.
- ✓ The goal is for the child to receive in-home and community-based services.

## How does WV Wraparound work?

- ✓ All services are coordinated within WV Wraparound, including Safe at Home West Virginia (SAH) and the Children with Serious Emotional Disorder (CSED) Waiver.
- ✓ WV Wraparound can serve children and youth ages 3 through 20 (before age 21).
- ✓ A child and their family may be referred to WV Wraparound by DoHS staff.
- ✓ Families can contact the CCRL anytime, 24 hours/day, 7 days/week.
- ✓ WV Wraparound generally concludes within 9 – 12 months of initiation.
